THEMED COMPETITION RULES

BACKGROUND

To present a new challenge for Club Members, and that it is simple to enter by cutting out the printing process. This will hopefully encourage Members to expand their technical and artistic abilities in a new direction by interpreting the theme.

THE COMPETITION

The competition will be titled simply “Annual Themed Competition”, and the award will be known as Themer Of The Year

It will be open to all Current Members on the day of the competition.

The theme for each month will be selected randomly for each year by dice roll from a substantial list to remove bias prior to programme completion.

Members may enter ONE projected digital image (as defined by current rules and regulations). The image, which must be identified as THEMED for the projectionist on the file title, not the metadata

The images may be Monochrome, Colour, or any mixture, to be judged on quality and theme relevance. The judging of this category will commence after the completion of judging of the Open Projected Images.

The image will not have been entered in any prior club competition. Entries should not have been used in previous Themed Competition nor may they be used in any subsequent Themed Competitions but they may be used in subsequent Monthly Competitions in accordance with the Club’s General Competition Rules.

The themed competition will be held after every open competition and cumulative scores will be kept throughout the year. Prizes will be awarded based on the year’s aggregated scores for each entrant after the last Themed Competition in September.

The usual club rules and regulations for entries will apply.

THE TROPHY

There will be trophies for the Winner and keepsakes for the two runners up.

These will be presented at the Annual Club Dinner.
